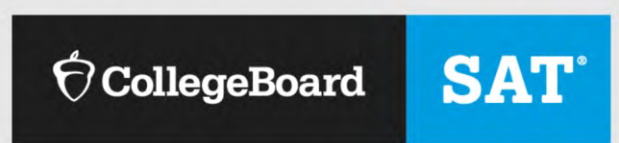






## About the school
