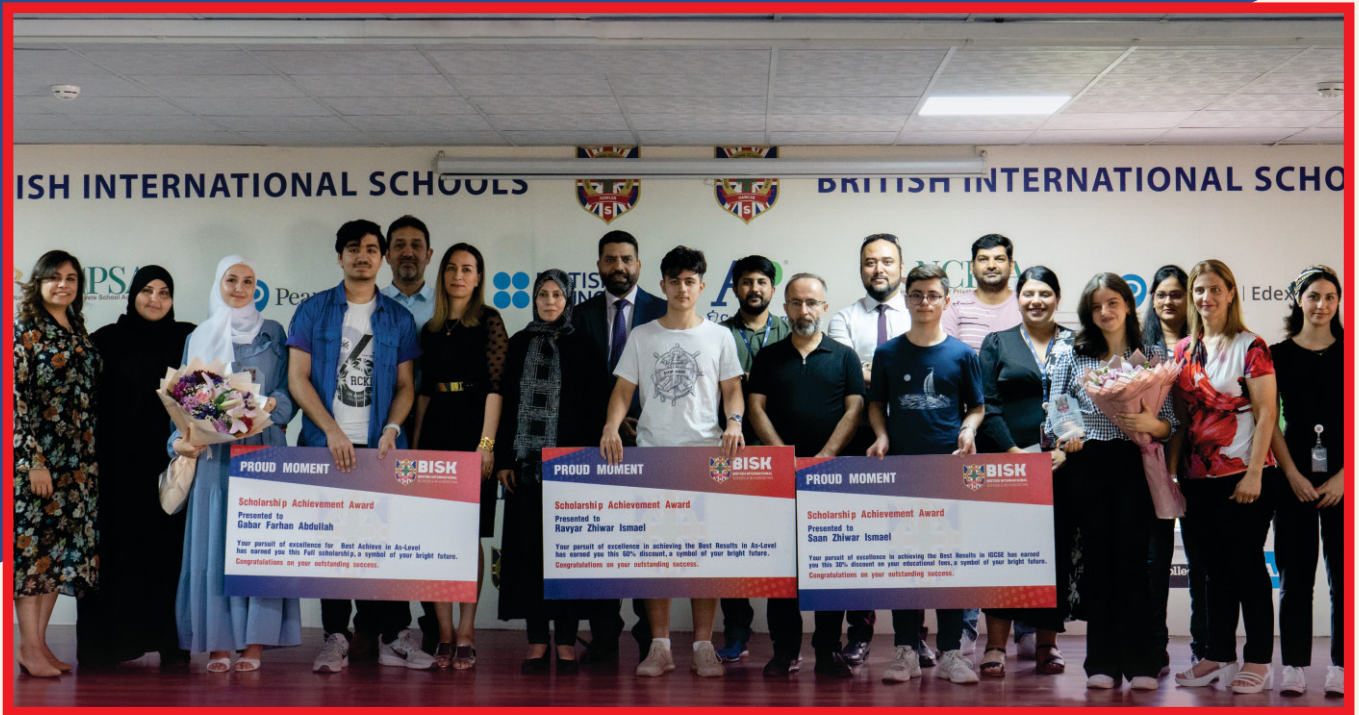

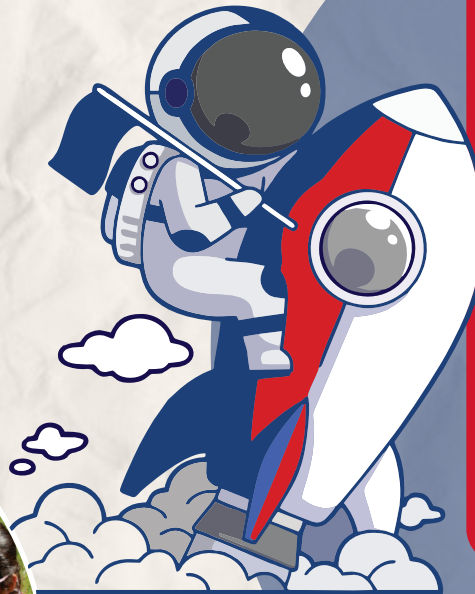


prophet's birthday

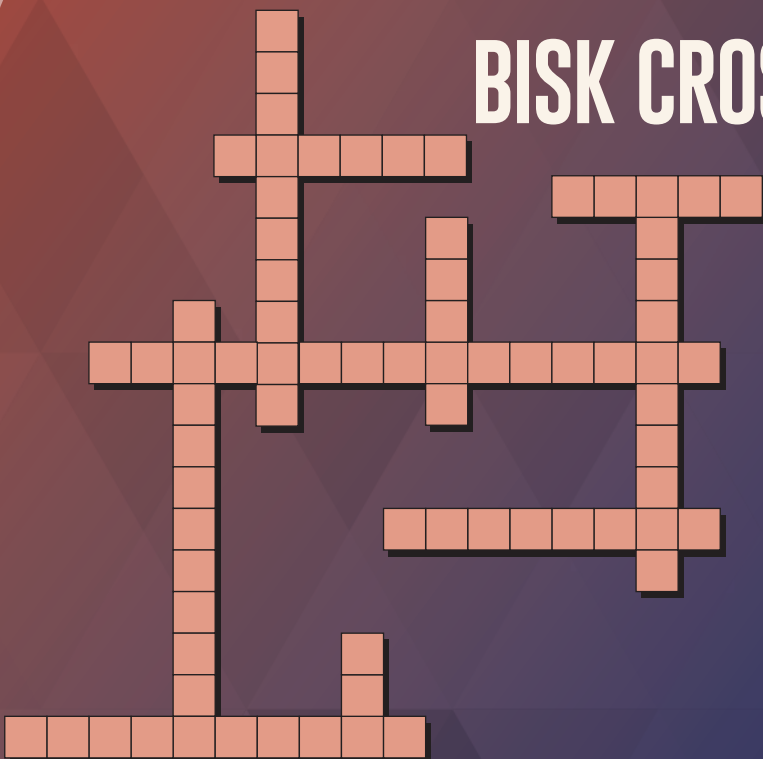
